Syllable Types	Pattern & Sound	Example
	1 vowel, closed at the end = Short Vowel	Că t
	1 vowel, open at the end = Long Vowel	Hē
	3 ("sticky") letters = weird sound	H o n k
	Vowel, Consonant, Silent E = Long sound (usually)	Grā pē
	2 vowels, 1 sound = Long Sound	Blūē
	Vowel + R = Bossy R sound	Sh ar k
	Consonant + le	B u b blē
