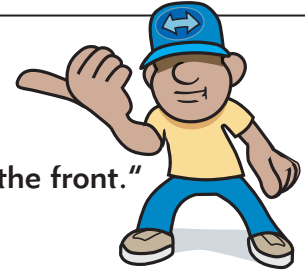

in the middle

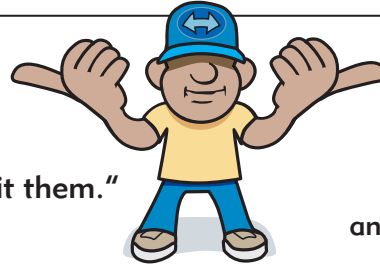


"Slide it to the end."



"Slide it to the front."

2 Letters
in the middle



"Split them."

"Watch out for digraphs
and r or l in the 2nd position."

3 Letters
in the middle



"Give it the one-two split."

4 Letters
in the middle



"Give it the one-three split."

Compound
Words



"Pull them apart."

For the Instructor:

All steps need to be followed from left to right in the same direction we read. For multisyllable words, draw the syllable division line between the first and second vowel, then the second and third vowel, next the third and fourth vowel, etc. Do not split apart units or digraphs. Treat them as one letter.

This student guide is a visual reminder. It should only be used after students have received explicit instruction in syllable division rules.
